

SCHOLARSHIP 2019-2020

The ALFRED APFEL AND ROBERT MINUCCIANNI SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The funds are made available to students attending college or coatings industry participants attending short courses – for tuition only.

ELIGIBILITY _ To be eligible, the student's parent or guardian must be a member in good standing with the GGSC. Preference will be given to applicants whose sponsor is currently active in GGSC meetings. Industry applicants must be members.

Applicants may include:

- (1) Students attending college;
- (2) Coating industry participants who are currently employed in the coatings industry and who are members of the Society or dependents of members.
- (3) Coatings industry participants attending short courses for tuition only

All applicants must also declare a vocational interest or be involved in an occupation that is viable to the coatings industry.

APPLICATION- Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Official application form
- 2. Students – official copies (no photocopies) of high school transcripts showing grades of all classes attended in all schools.
- 3. College students – current college students should in addition to (2), submit transcripts of grades for all college classes taken to date.
- 4. A letter of 200-300 words describing past school and extracurricular activities, past work experience and future career plans.
- 5. Industry participants must submit a letter of 100-200 words describing why they want to take the short course.

Short course applications are accepted throughout the year. Registration fees for Western Coatings Symposium & Show or other technical shows will be included in definition of a short course and eligible for a scholarship.

Application and all supporting documentation for college scholarships must be submitted no later than July 31st, 2019 for the 2019-2020 year.
